

## **REBUILT AUTHORIZATIONS**

If you wish to get a rebuilt title on a salvaged vehicle, you will need the following:

1. If you do not have a salvaged title, you need to apply for one. Bring the current title and license plate to the County Clerk's office. Tell the clerk you need a salvage title and a rebuilt packet. The vehicle cannot be driven with a salvage title.
2. The rebuilt packet includes:
  - a. Labor Statement. This needs to be completed and notarized.
  - b. TC 96-215- Affidavit of Motor Vehicle Assembled from Wrecked or Salvaged Motor Vehicles. This needs to be completed and notarized.
  - c. TC 96-182 Application for Kentucky Certificate of Title or Registration. This form needs to be taken to the Sheriff's Department along with the Salvage Title, for vehicle inspection.
  - d. All ORIGINAL receipts for parts and labor for the repair of the vehicle. This includes any receipts from junkyards, auto parts stores, etc.
3. The salvage title and rebuilt packet needs to be returned to the County Clerk's office. At this time, we will submit the information to Frankfort via email. You also have the option to take the paperwork to Frankfort.
4. Frankfort reviews the documents and issues a rebuilt authorization number. With this, we can issue a new license plate and a rebuilt title. If they refuse the request, they will send the applicant a letter stating the reason(s) why it was rejected.
5. When you apply for the rebuilt title, you will need a current proof of insurance on the vehicle if you wish to get a new plate.
